

## **Laboratory/X-Ray Supervisor**

The ideal candidate will have the following education and experience:

- Two (2) years' experience as a laboratory technician.
- Demonstrated ability to maintain, operate, and troubleshoot all of the instruments in the laboratory.
- Demonstrated flexibility and ability to adjust to changes in workload.
- Leadership experience in a health care and/or medical office.
- National Registry certification MLT, MT, MLS or HEW

The ideal candidate will also possess the following knowledge, skills, and abilities:

- Supervises and instructs laboratory and radiology personnel
- Performs moderate complexity laboratory duties, including but not limited to, routine laboratory testing and complicated blood draws
- Responsible for all aspects of urine drug screen collections
- Oversees laboratory inventory control, including ordering and monitoring of supplies and equipment Responsible for monitoring, adjustment, and gathering of quality control and proficiency testing data, and new test/instrument evaluations for Laboratory Director
- Supervises radiologic duties; assists Radiologic Technologist with operation of radiology equipment, as necessary
- Participates in facility-wide Quality Assurance (QA)/Quality Improvement (QI) program m, ensuring that laboratory QA/QI activities are implemented, and performs QA/QI activities
- Ensures laboratory and radiology departments meet external regulatory requirements; makes recommendations to the Medical Director for operational improvements
- Cross-trains all necessary personnel in venipuncture techniques, quality control testing, and drug screening procedures
- Other duties as assigned
